

WHAT CAN I BORROW?

Visit our website, normalpl.org, and search the catalog to explore the wide variety of books, magazines, movies, board games, tech toys and more available for you to borrow for free. Eligible items will automatically renew after your two week check out period. You will be notified of new due dates by email.

HOW DO I FIND ITEMS TO CHECK OUT?

Use our online catalog, RSAcat mobile app or give us a call at 309.452.1757 to find your books and put them on hold. Not sure exactly what you feel like reading? Fill out the Browser Pack form on our website and let us surprise you with a selection of items chosen to fit your tastes. Browser Packs are great for families—you can request books for up to four different readers of any age in one pack.

HOW DO I GET MY MATERIALS?



Using Curb It, our curbside pickup service, is as easy as 1, 2, 3!

- **1.** Place your hold requests through our online catalog, the RSAcat mobile app or by calling us at 309.452.1757.
- 2. When your Browser Pack or hold items are ready, you will receive an email notification. If you do not have an email on your account, we will call you to let you know your items are ready to be picked up. You may then schedule a pickup time or swing by to pick up your items.
- 3. When you arrive, pull into one of the numbered spots in our main parking lot. Call or text the posted phone number to let us know you are here. Pop your trunk or open a door and library staff will place your items in your vehicle.



NPL is now permanently fine free! All previous overdue fines have been erased. If you had fees on your account due to lost items, damaged items or collections, you will still need to settle your account to get your card ready to borrow items once again. We are happy to work with you to get your account in good standing!

HOW DO I RETURN ITEMS?

You may return items via our Curb It service when you arrive for your pickup. Items may also be dropped into the book return in our main parking lot or at one of our off-site drops. Returned items will be quarantined, so please be aware that your account may show items still checked out to you for a week or more after they have been returned.

HOW DO I GET A LIBRARY CARD?
